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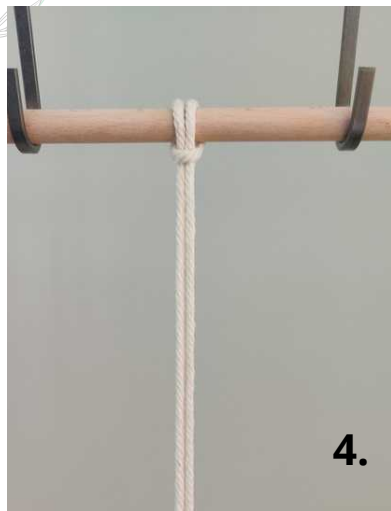
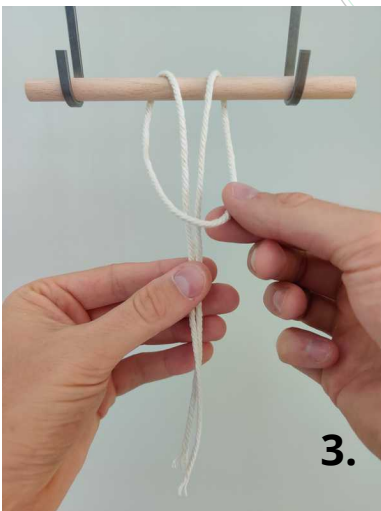
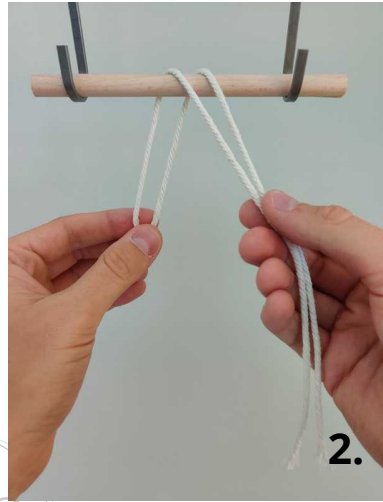
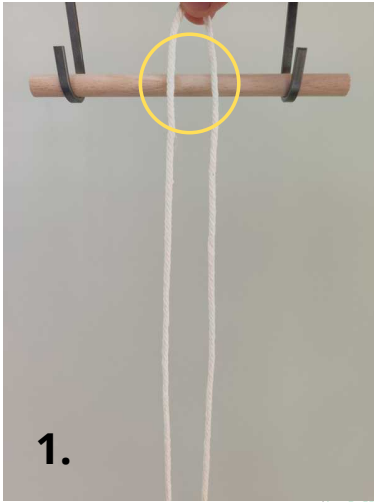
Overhand Knot

The overhand knot is one of the simplest knot. You just have to make a loop with a string and pull one end through. Then, pull on the ends to tighten.



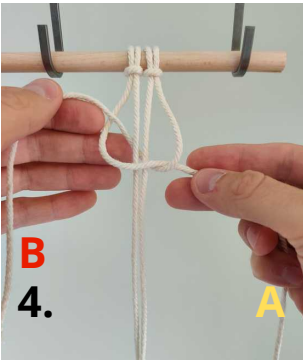
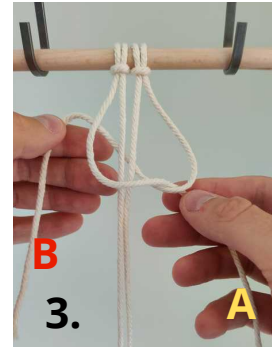
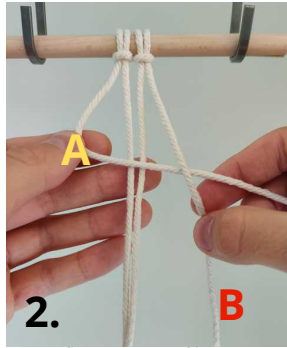
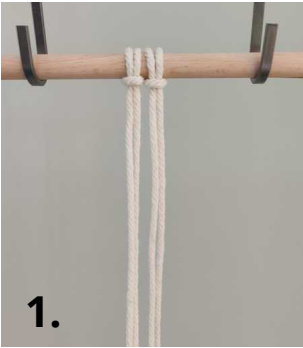
Lark's Head Knot

Take a single string and fold it in half. Place loop above the dowel (1). Then fold the loop down behind the folding cord (2). After that pull ends through the loop (3). In the end pull tight (4).

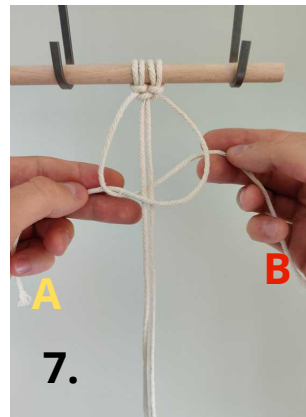
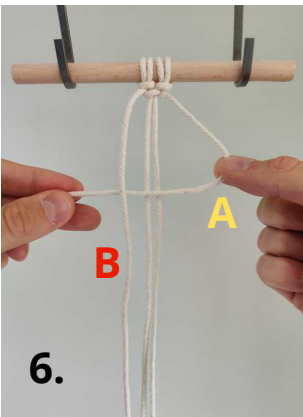


Square Knot

Start with two Lark's Head Knots (1). Then, cross the outer left "A" cord loosely **over** the two center strings, and **under** the outer right "B" cord (2). Next, take the external right string (3-B) **under** both center strings, and up through the loop made by the outer left "A" string. Pull both outer strings out(4)

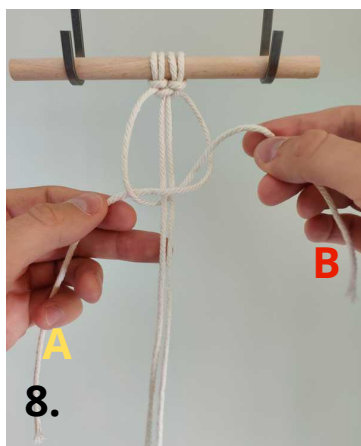


...and tight until the knot fits snugly against the top knot (5).



Cross the outer right "A" cord loosely **over** the two center strings, and **under** the outer left "B" string (6). Next, take the external left "B" string under both center strings, and up through the loop made by the outer "A" right string (7). Now, pull both outer strings out and tight until the knot fits with your first knot.

Now, pull both outer strings and tight until the knot fits with your first knot (8). You have completed the full Square Knot (9)

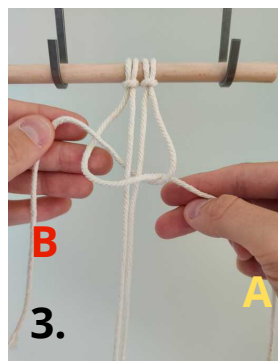
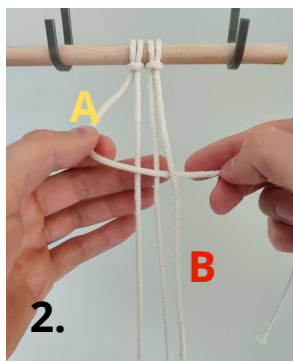
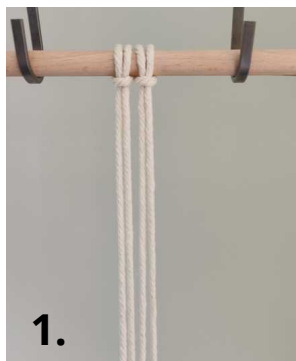


Spiral Knot

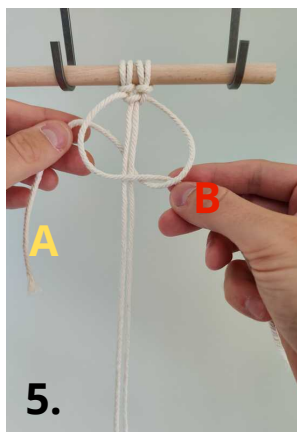
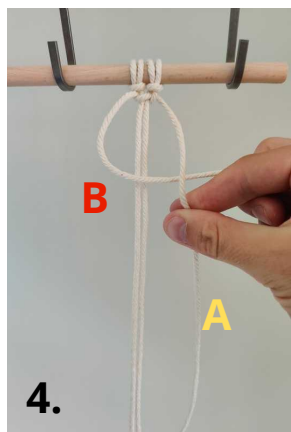
Start with two Lark's Head Knots (1). Then, cross the outer left "A" cord loosely **over** the two center strings, and **under** the outer right "B" cord (2).

Next, take the external right string "B" (3) under both center strings, and up through the loop made by the outer left "A" string (3).

Pull both outer strings.



Repeat previous steps. Cross the outer left "B" cord loosely **over** the two center strings, and **under** the outer right "A" string (4). Next, take the external right "A" string **under** both center strings, and up through the loop made by the outer left "B" string (5). Pull both outer strings out (6). Pull both outer strings out (6).



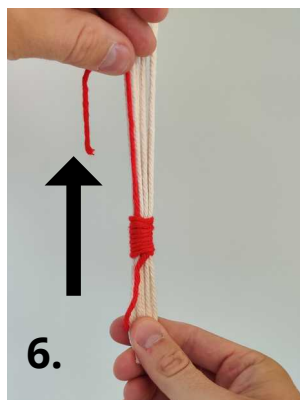
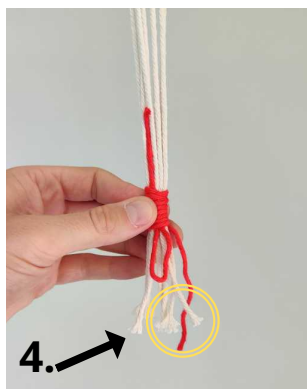
Wrapping Knot

At the beginning, grab all of the cords together vertically. Using another string, place the string in the middle (1). Take the end (2) and start wrapping the long end around the bundle of cords several times (3). Be sure to wrap it tightly and hold in place using your thumb.



After wrapping around, you should have a loop below the bundle (5- black arrow). When you have wrapped almost to the bottom of the loop, pull bottom string through the loop (5)(6) (yellow circle).

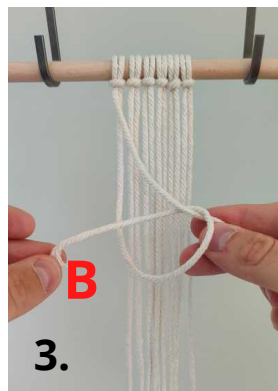
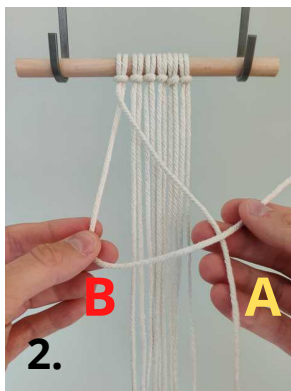
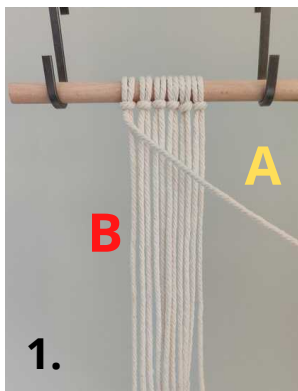
Then, pull on the top end of the wrapping cord to tighten (7). In the end trim the ends. You have completed the **Wrapping knot**.



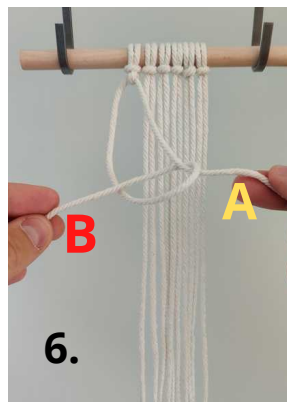
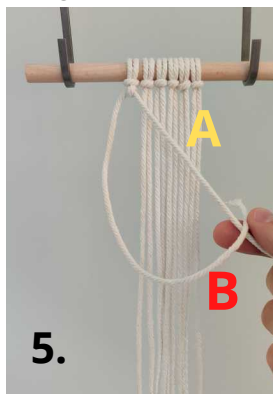
Double Half Hitch Knot

Cross the outer left "A" cord (holding cord) loosely over the right "B" cord (working cord)(1). Next cross the cord "B" loosely **over** the cord "A"(2).

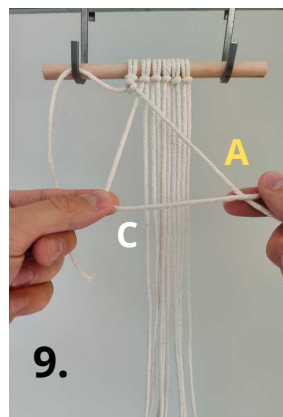
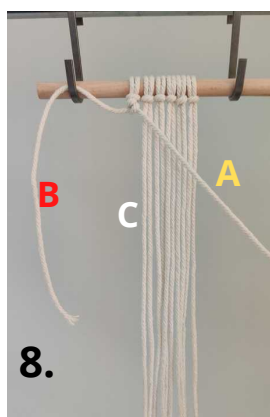
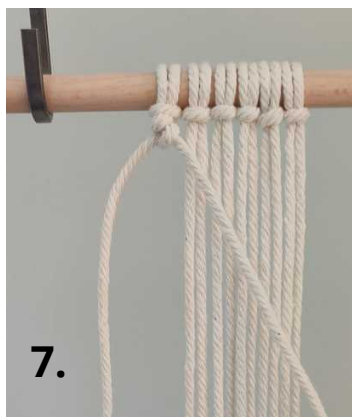
Then, loop cord "B" through the loop (3) and pull tight(4).



Again, cross the outer left "B" cord (working cord) loosely **over** the "A" cord(holding cord)(5). Loop "B" cord through the loop/hole (6) and pull tight both cords.

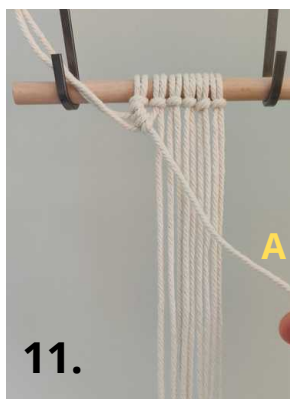
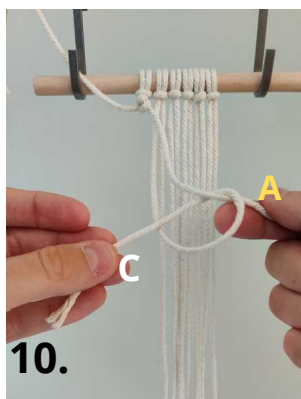


Next step to do is to grab another string "C" from the second Lark's Hed Knot (8). Cross the outer left "C" cord loosely **over** the "A" cord (9).



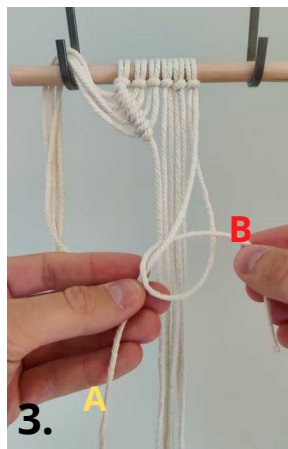
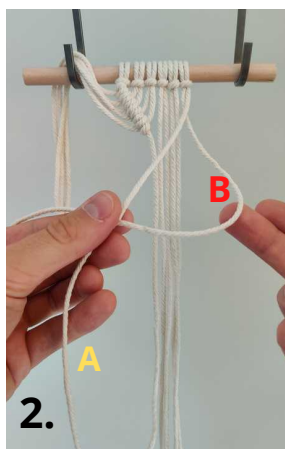
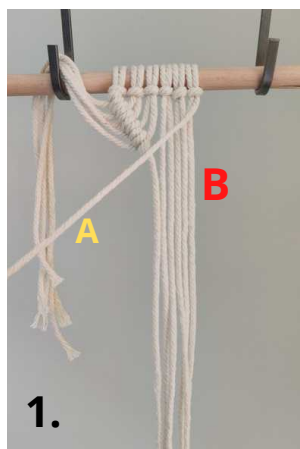
Loop "C" cord through the loop (10) and pull tight both cords.
Repeat the same step once more. Then take another string placed
next to each other as your working cord and repeat previous steps.

Always keep "A" cord as your holding cord



Reverse Double Half Hitch Knot

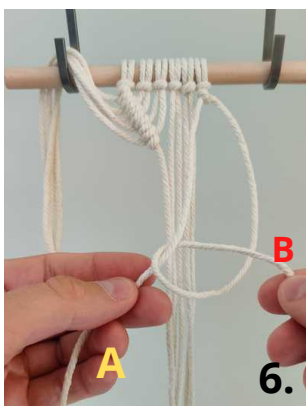
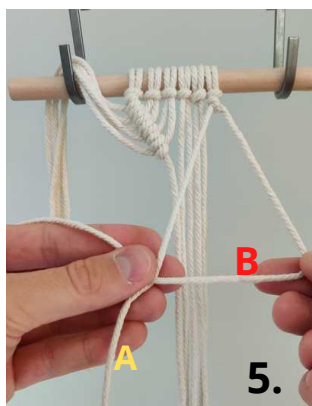
Cross the outer right "A" holding cord loosely over the "B" working
cord(1). Next cross the cord "B" loosely **over** the cord "A"(2). Loop cord
"B" through the loop (3) and pull tight. **Half Hitch Knot is ready.**



Once more, cross the outer right "B" cord loosely **over** the "A" cord (5).

Then loop cord "B" through the loop (6). Pull tight both cords.

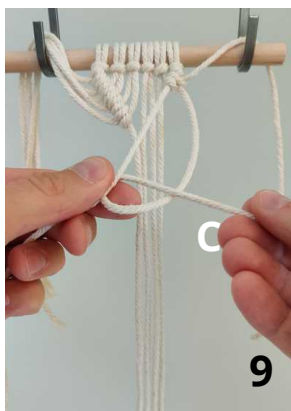
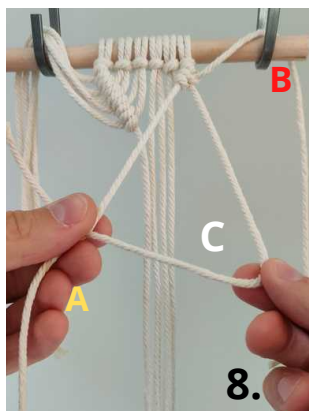
Reverse Double Half Hitch Knot is ready (7).



Next step to do is to grab another string "C" from the second Lark's Hed Knot. Cross the outer "C" cord loosely **over** the "A" cord (8).

Loop "C" cord through the loop (9) and pull tight both cords. Once more tie another Half Hitch Knot, repeating steps: *"Cross the outer "C" cord loosely over the "A" cord. Loop "C" cord through the loop and pull tight both cords.* Repeat the same with remaining strings next to each other.

Always keep "A" cord as your holding cord

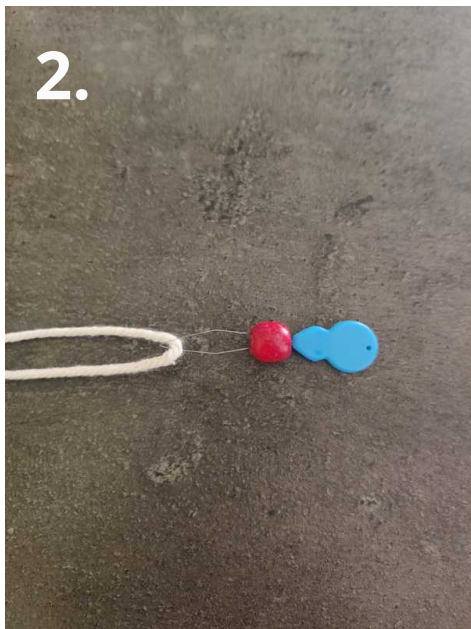

TIP2:

How to thread without needle threader?

Take adhesive tape and tie around the string, then thread the string into the bead.

Materials:

- 20 cords 79 inches (2m) each
- 1 cord 24 inches (60cm)
- wooden dowel 12 inch (30cm) long
- 20 wooden beads
- measuring tape
- scissors

STEP1

Cut 16 strings 79in -2m long each. Using these cords make 16 Lark's Head Knots (1). Make sure the ends are even. Use 16 wooden beads. Thread each cord through the wooden beads (2).

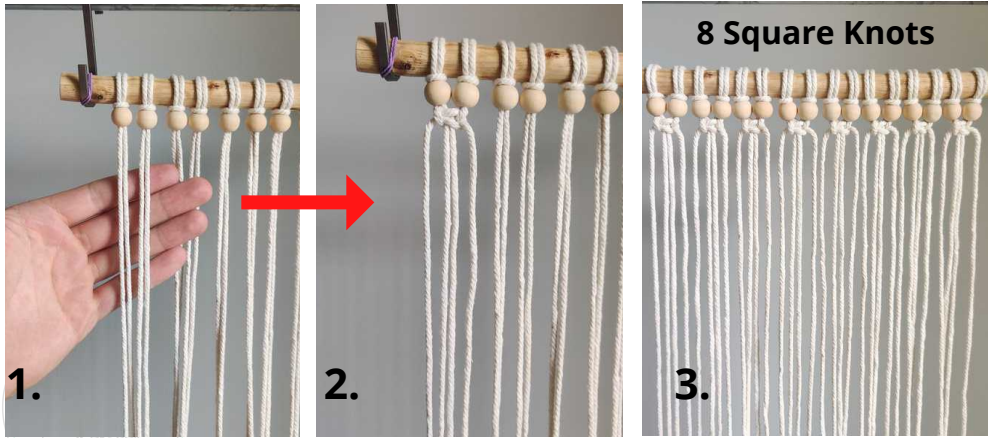

STEP 2

Take first four strings from the left side (1) and make **Square Knot** (2). Using another four strings make once more **Square Knot**.

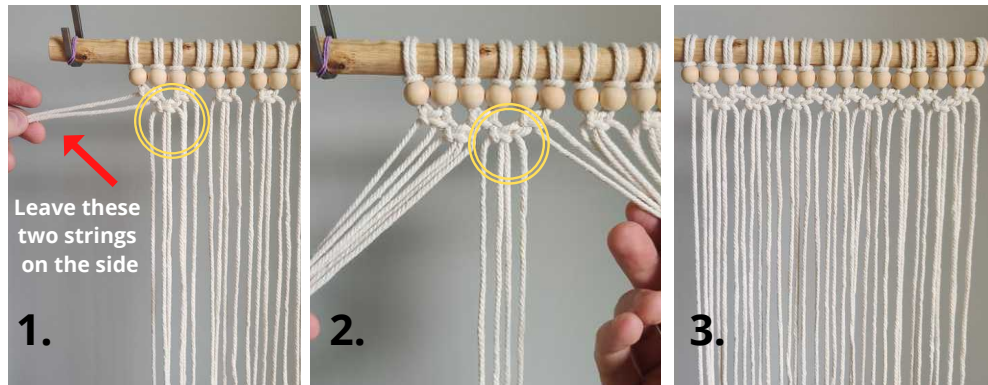
Make in total - **8 Square Knots** (3)



STEP 3

Leave on the left and the right side two strings (1). Grab four strings next to each other and make **Square Knot** - **yellow circle**(1). Now take another four strings and make another **Square Knot** (2).

In this row you should have in total - **7 Square Knots**.



For the 3rd row leave on the side (left and right) four strings and make in total - **6 Square Knots**

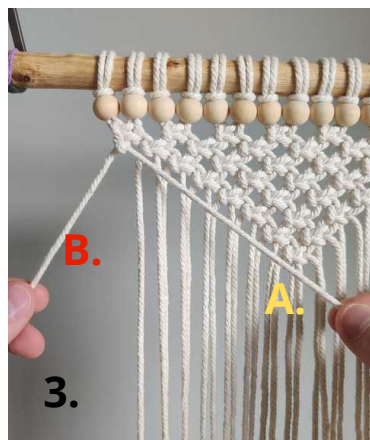
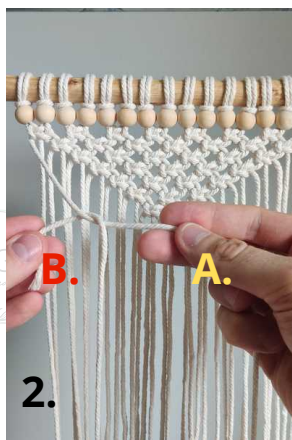
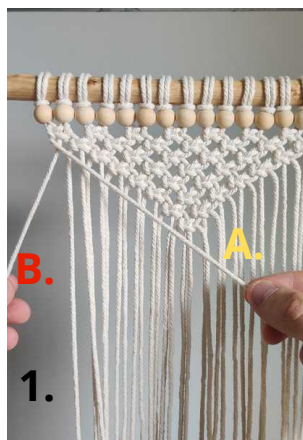


- *For the 4th row, leave on the (left and right) side 6 strings and make in total
- **5 Square Knot**
- *For the 5th row leave on the (left and right) side 8 strings and make in total
- **4 Square Knots**
- *For the 6th row leave on the (left and right) side 10 strings and make
in total - **3 Square Knot**
- *For the 7th row leave on the (left and right) side 12 strings and make in
total - **2 Square Knots**
- *For the last row leave on the (left and right) side 14 strings and make in
total - **1 Square Knot (5)**

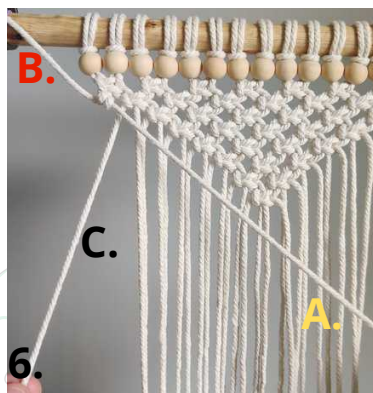
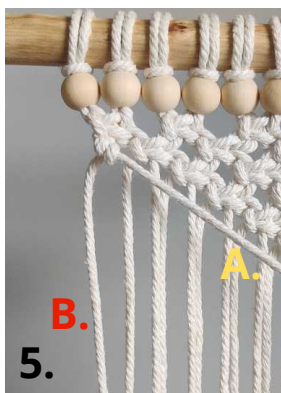
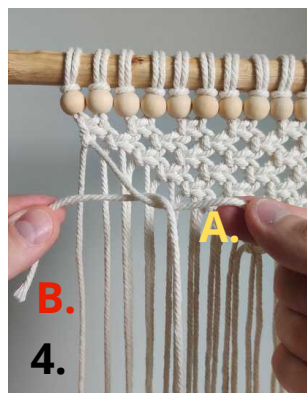


STEP 4- Double Half Hitch Knot section

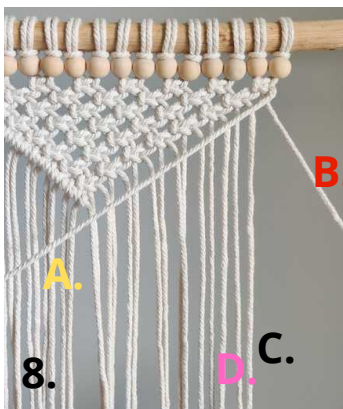
Take the left string and hold it diagonally. **It's holding cord.** the others will be your working cords (1). Take the working cord (**red color B.**), you will then loop it around the holding cord (2-3)



Once more loop the working cord around the holding cord to where the loop is facing fown and the tail of the working cord is up (4). You should have two loops around the holding cord (5-6). Continue the same knot on the following working cords -next to each other, keeping your holding cord the same. Stop once you get to the middle of your cords (7).

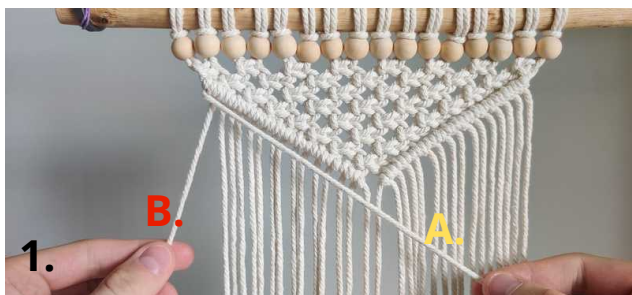


Repeat the same on the right side. **A.** cord is your holding cord and the **B,C,D..** are your working cords. Ready **Double Half Hitch Knot** section on the right side. Don't connect both sides yet (9).

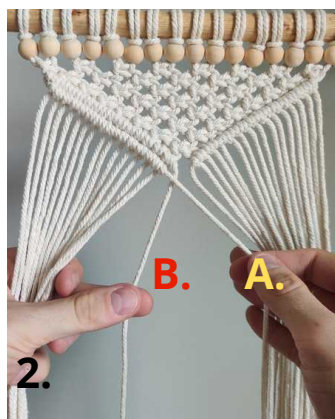


STEP 5

Repeat the same below the first **Double Half Hitch Knot** section (1).



Final knot on the left side will be connected with the end string of the first row (2). Second row on the left side is ready (3). You can repeat the same on the right side (4). Ready **Double Half Hitch Knot** sections for both sides (5).

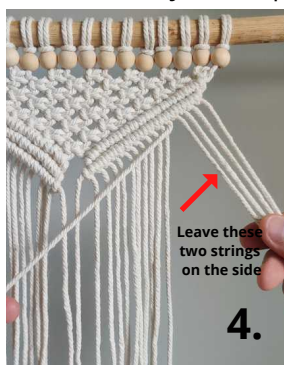


STEP 6

Leave on the **side four strings** and make another **Double Half Hitch Knot** section(1). The last knotting will be finished using the last cord from the second row.



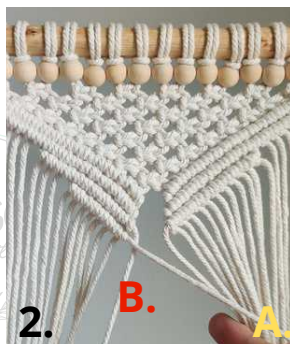
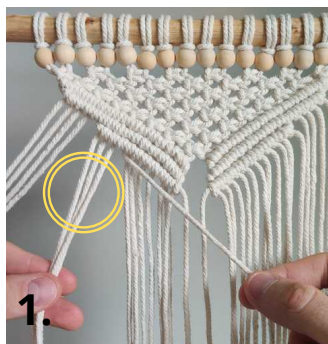
Ready third row of the **Double Half Hitch Knot** on the left side (3). Repeat the same on the right side. Leave four strings on the side (4). Right side is ready of our project (5).



STEP 7

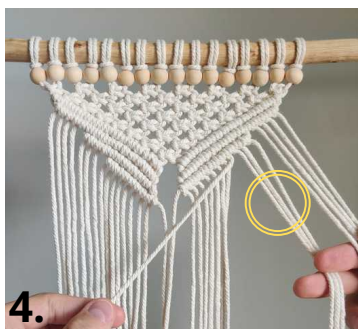
Leave on the side another three strings (**yellow circle**) and make another **Double Half Hitch Knot** section(1). The last knotting will be finished using the last cord from the third row (2).

Ready fourth row of the **Double Half Hitch Knot** on the left side (3).



Repeat the same on the right side. Leave another three strings on the side (**yellow circle**) and make **Double Half Hitch Knot** section(4).

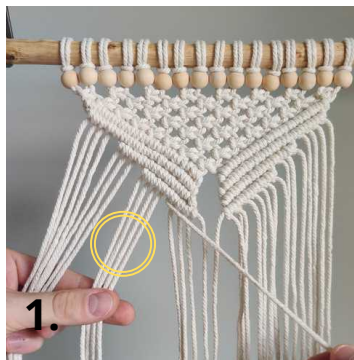
Ready fourth row of **Double Half Hitch Knot** section(5).

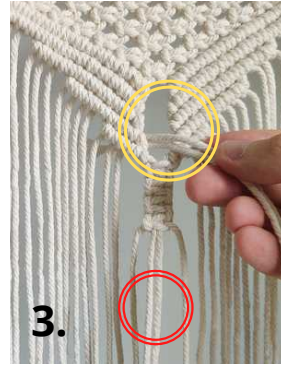
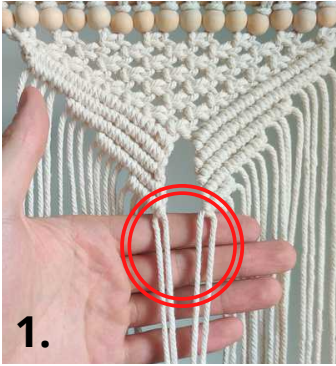
Leave on the side another four strings (**yellow circle**) and make **Double Half Hitch Knot** section(1) - repeat the same on the right side.

Fifth row of **Double Half Hitch Knot** section is ready (2).

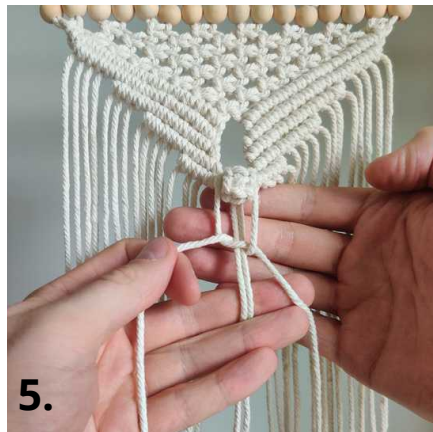
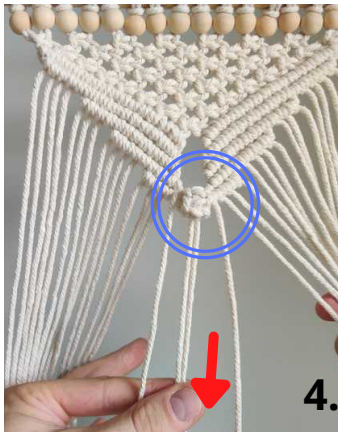


STEP 9

Grab four middle string and make **four Square Knots**(1-2). Then take two middle strings (**red circle**) and thread them through the gap at the top of the first **Square Knot** -**yellow circle** (3) and pull down these strings (**red arrow**) making **Berry Knot**-**blue circle** (4)

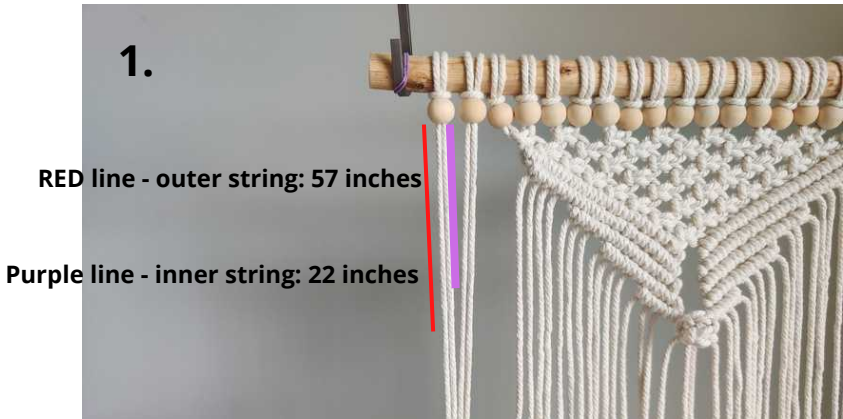


Secure the **Berry Knot** with **Square Knot** below it (5).

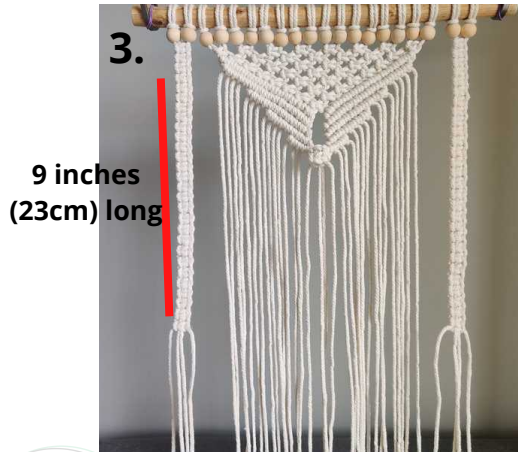


STEP 10

Add another two 79 inches (2m) cords and make a **Lark's Head Knot** adding two beads in the same way as at the beginning of this project. For each **Lark's Head Knot** make the outer string longer than the inner one. Outer string 57 inches (1.45m) long and the inner one: 22 inches (55cm)(1).



Take two outer strings and make **Square Knot** section - 9 inches (23cm) long. Then Repeat the same on the right side. Add four strings --> make **Lark's Head Knot** --> thread the beads --> **Square Knot** section.



STEP 11

Connect both sides by making **Square Knot**(1-2).
Take two outer string and make **Square Knot** (2-3)



Ready **Square Knot** (5).

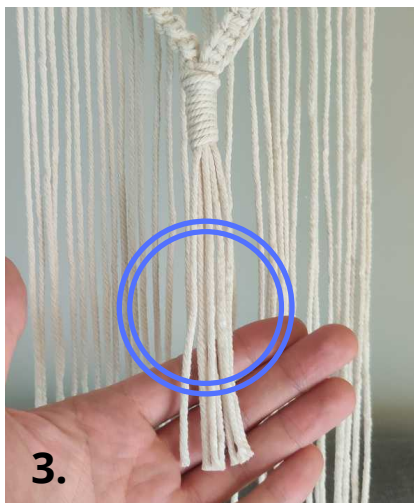


STEP 12

Take another 24 inches (60cm) string and finish with the **Wrapping Knot** (1-2).



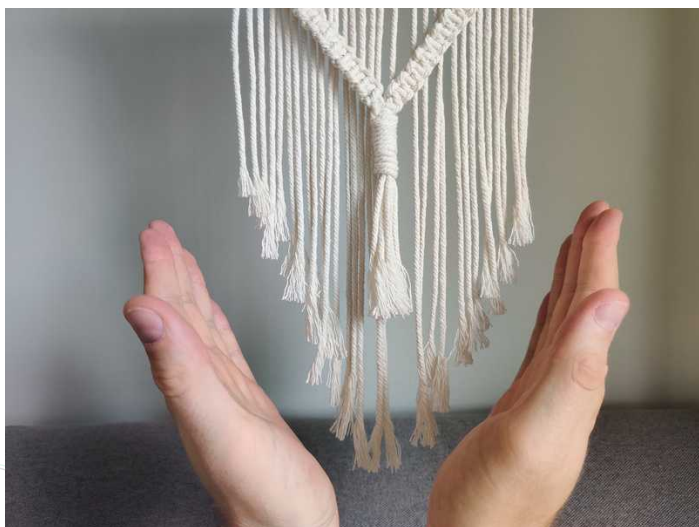
Wrapping Knot is ready (3). You can shorten this string a bit (**blue circle**).



STEP 13

In the end trim each string - from shortest on the side to longer in the middle and brush out each string.

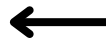

- 18 cords 118 inches (3 m) each
- scissors
- wooden dowel 12 inch (30cm) long
- 2x wooden beads
- measuring tape
- 4 cords 157 inches (4m) each - (bonus part)



STEP 1

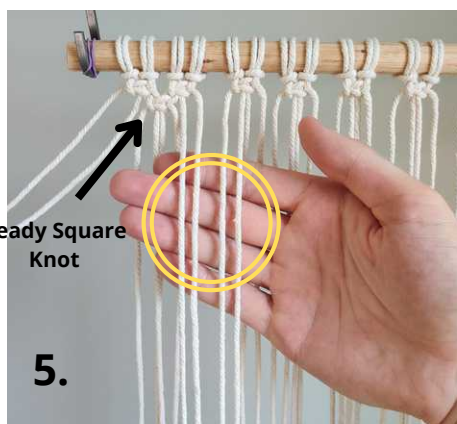
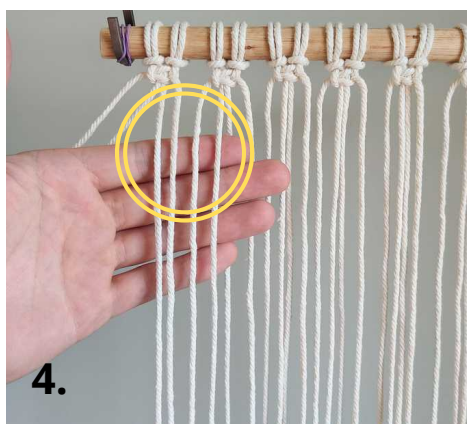
Cut 18 strings 118 inches - 3m long each. Using these cords make **18 Lark's Head Knots** (1). Make sure the ends are even. Then, using first four strings (from two Lark's Head Knots) make a **Square Knot** (2).



In first row make in total - **9 Square Knots** (2). Next, leave on the left and the right side two strings - yellow circle (3). Grab four strings next to each other and make **Square Knot** (4).



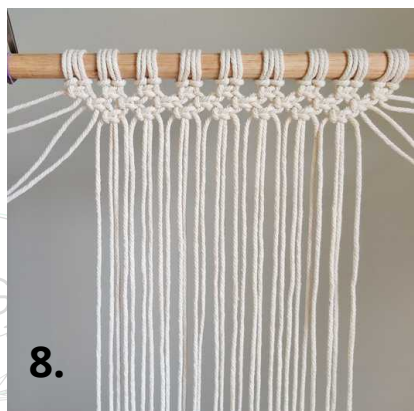
Then, grab another four strings next to each other and repeat the same (5).
In the second row make in total - **8 Square Knots** (5-6).



Ready **8 Square Knots** (6).



In the 3rd row leave on the side (left and right) another two strings and make in total - **7 Square Knots(5)**. Ready **7 Square Knots(6)**



*For the 4th row, leave on the (left and right) another 2 strings and make in total - **6 Square Knot**

*For the 5th row leave on the (left and right) another 2 strings and make in total - **5 Square Knots**

*For the 6th row leave on the (left and right) another 2 strings and make in total - **4 Square Knot**

*For the 7th row leave on the (left and right) another 2 strings and make in total - **3 Square Knots**

*For the 8th row leave on the (left and right) another 2 strings and make in total - **2 Square Knot**

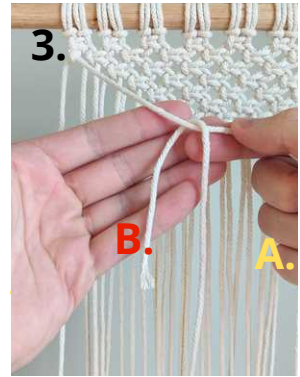
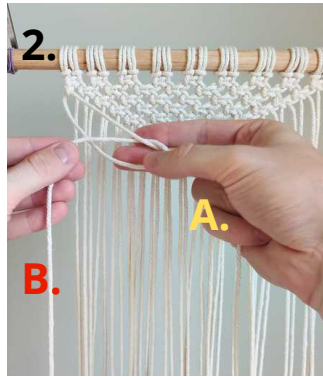
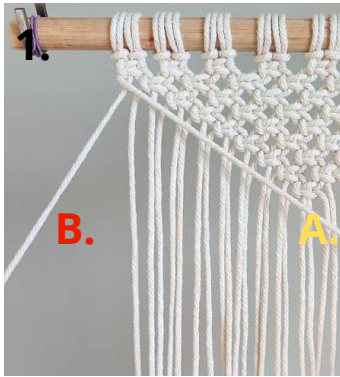
*For the 9th row leave on the (left and right) another 2 strings and make in total - **1 Square Knot**



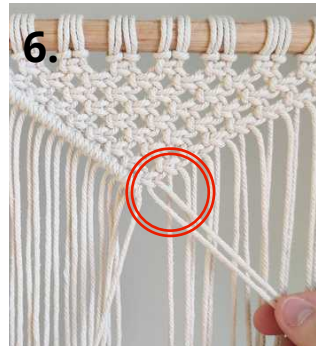
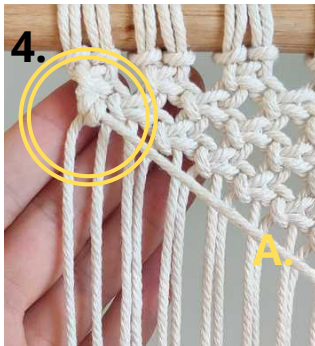
STEP 2- Double Half Hitch Knot section

Take the left "A" string and hold it diagonally. **It's going to be your holding cord "A"**, the others will be your working cords (1). Take the next working cord (**red color B.**), you will then loop it around the holding cord (2). Once more loop the **working cord** around the **holding cord** (3).

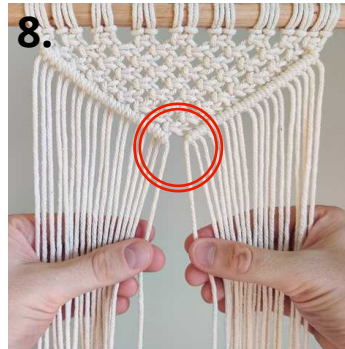
You should have two loops around the **holding cord**(4)



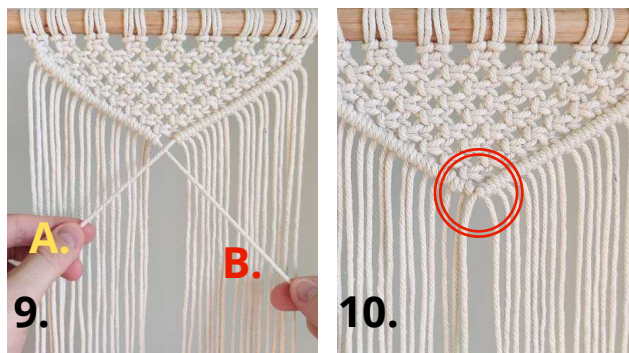
Continue with **Double Half Hitch Knot** section going to the center(5). You should have two strings from above **Square Knot** intended from the **Double Half Hitch Knot** section on the right side - red circle (6).



Repeat **Double Half Hitch Knot** section on the right side (7). Having both sides next to each other - connect them - **red circle** (8).

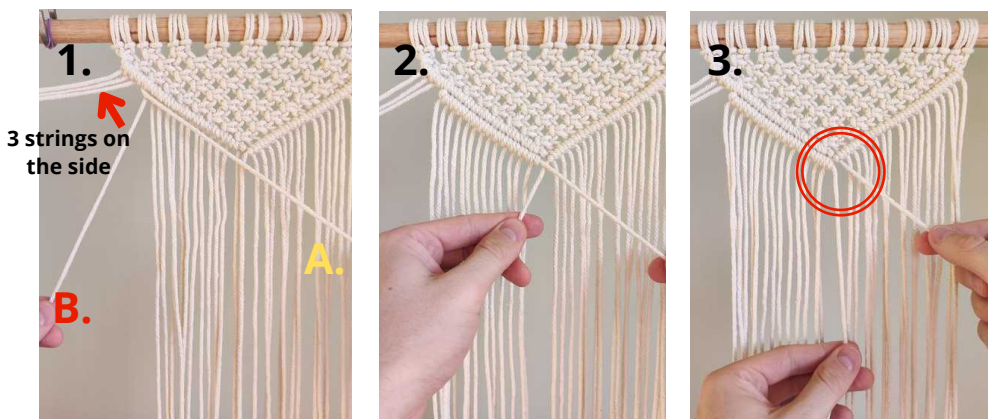


A. is your holding string and **B. working string**(9). Both sides are ready (10).



STEP 3

Leave on the side **three strings** and make another **Double Half Hitch Knot** section(1). Connect holding cord with the string from the first row - **red circle**(3)



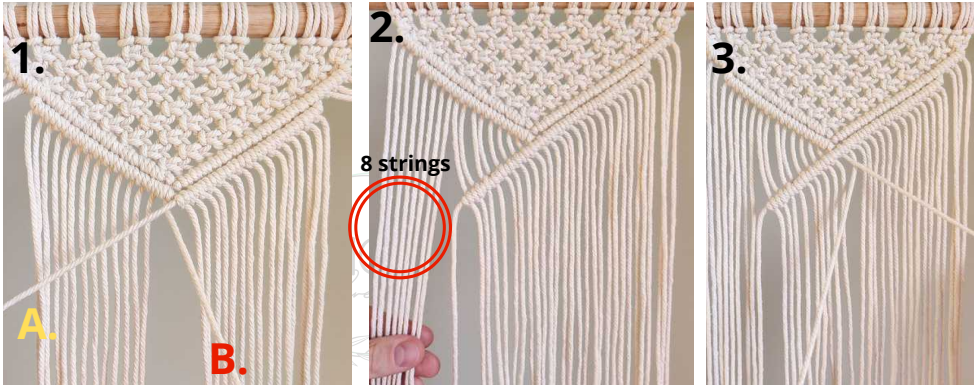
Repeat the same on the right side. Leave on the side **three strings** and make another **Double Half Hitch Knot** section(4).

Connect both sides with another **Double Half Hitch Knot** (5).

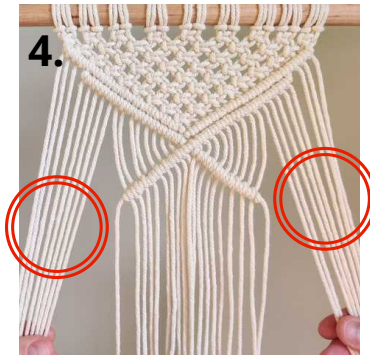


STEP 4

Using string "**A -your holding cord**" make another section of **Double Half Hitch Knot** (1). Make that amount of **Double Half Hitch Knot** to have 8 strings on the **left side - red circle** (2). Make the same on the right side (3).



You should have 8 strings on the left and the right side - **red circle** (4).

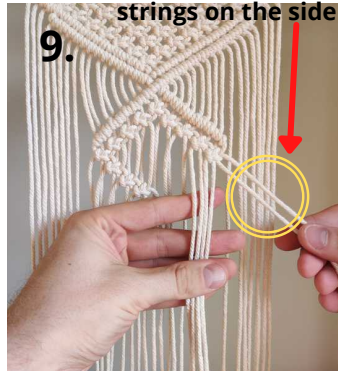
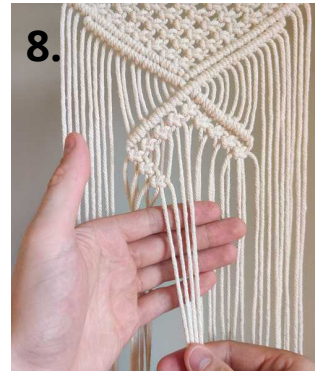
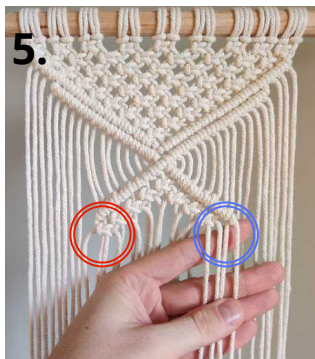
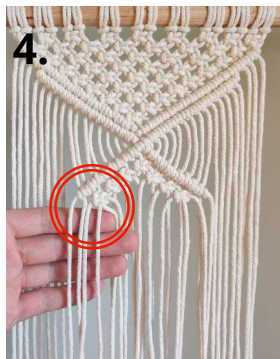


STEP 5

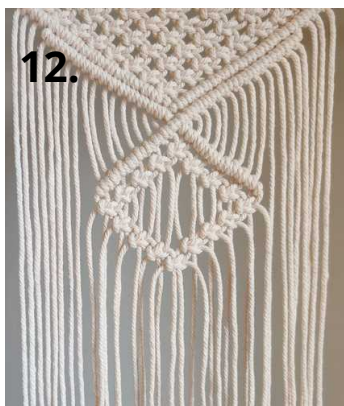
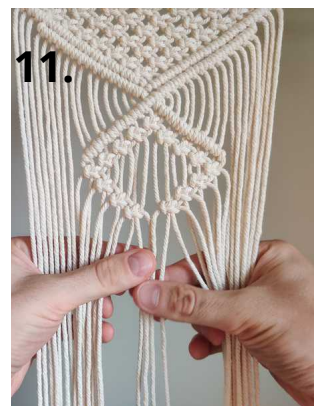
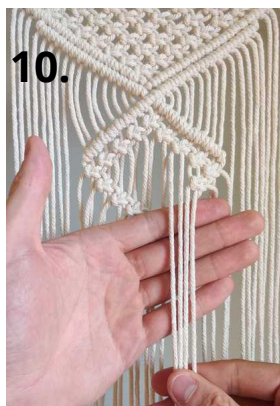
Using 4 middle strings make a **Square Knot**. Then, take two left strings from the ready **Square Knot** (2) and two adjacent strings (two from ready Square Knot, and the right/left strings from the other pair). Complete on both sides (3).



Starting with the first four string on the left side make **Square Knot** section - **red circle** (4). Repeat the same on the right side - blue circle (5). Leave 2 strings on the side (6) and repeat Square Knots the same going to the center

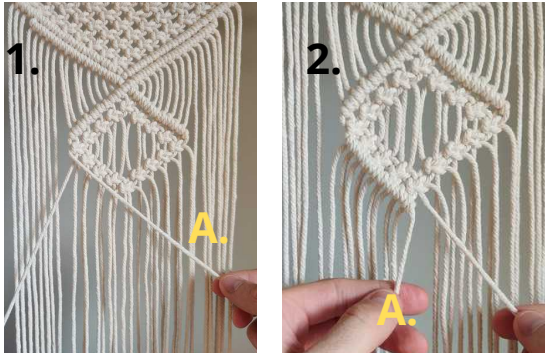


Make a **Square Knot** and repeat the same to the center (10). In the end connect both sides with another **Square Knot** (11-12).

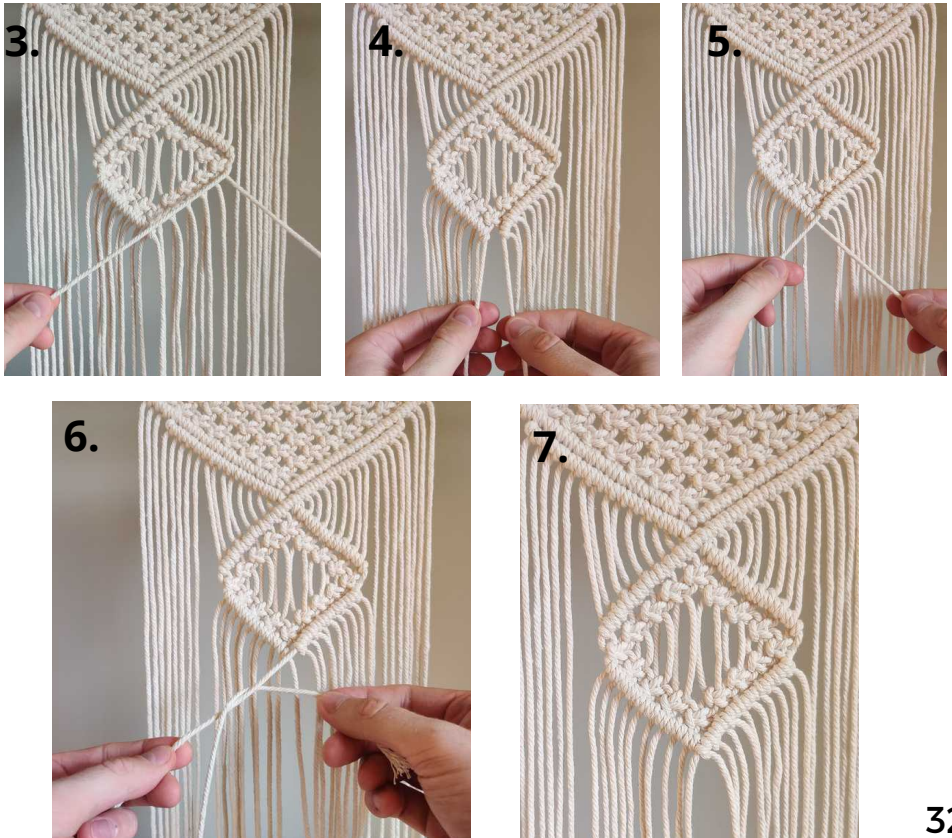


STEP 6

Starting from the left side (left string) make another **Double Half Hitch Knot** to the center. Use **A. cord** as you holding cord and the others as the working cords (1). Finish this side with left string from the above **Square Knot**. You should intend right string from above **Square Knot** for right section of **Double Half Hitch Knot** (2).

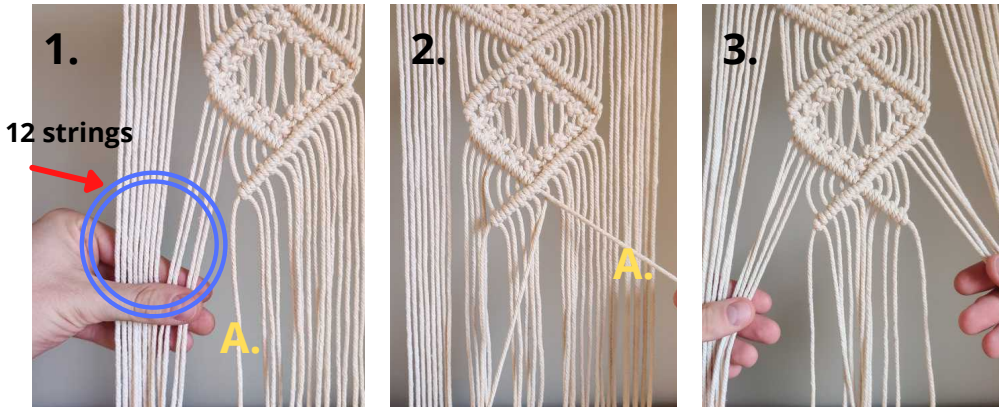


Repeat the same on the right side and connect both sides making another **Double Half Hitch Knot** (4-7)



STEP 7

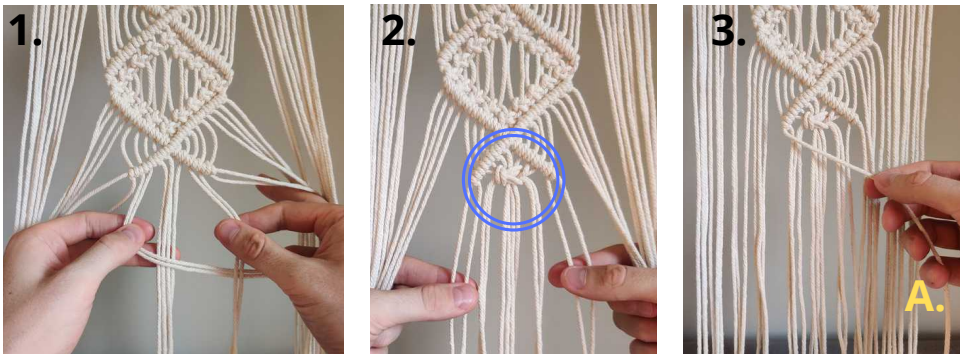
Again, use **A. cord** as your holding cord and make another section of **Double Half Hitch Knot** (1). Make that amount of **Double Half Hitch Knot** to have **12 strings on the left side** (1). Make the same on the right side. Use **A. cord** as your working cord and make **Double Half Hitch Knot** section (2-3).

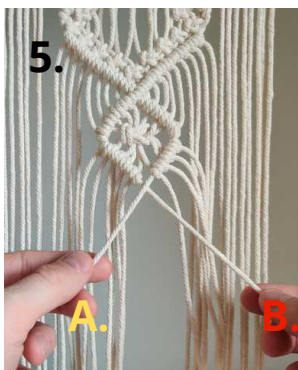
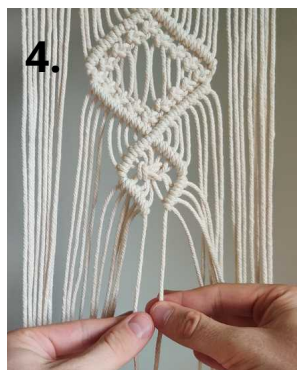
Grab two cords from the left and the right side and make a **Square Knot**.

Again, use **A. cord** as your holding cord and make another section of **Double Half Hitch Knot** to the center (3).



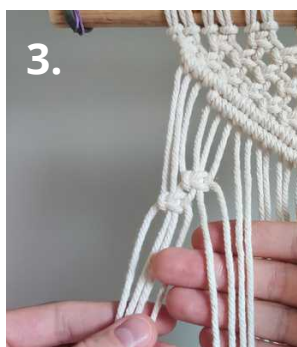
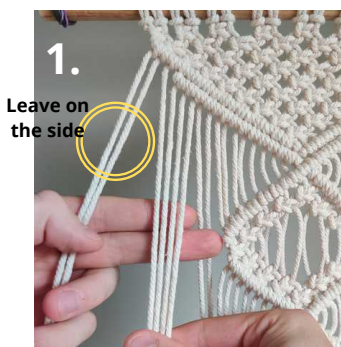
Repeat the same on the right side and connect both sides (4). Once more, use your **A. cord** as your holding cords and **B. cord** as your working cord(5).

Double Half Hitch Knot section is ready (6).

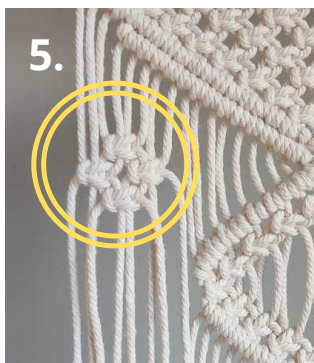
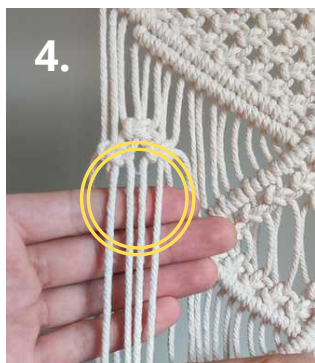


STEP 9

Leave on the side two strings, then take four strings next to each other and make a **Square Knot**(1). Then make the same on the left and the right side (2-3).



Once more repeat the same at the bottom (4). Ready **Square Knots** (5).



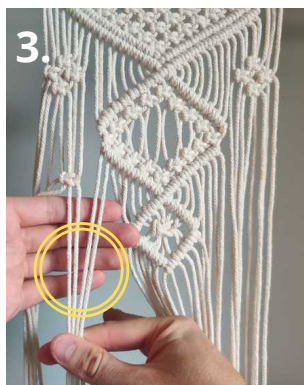
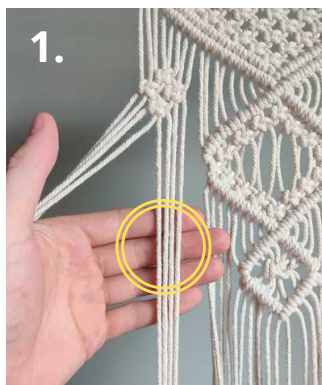

Repeat the same on the right side.

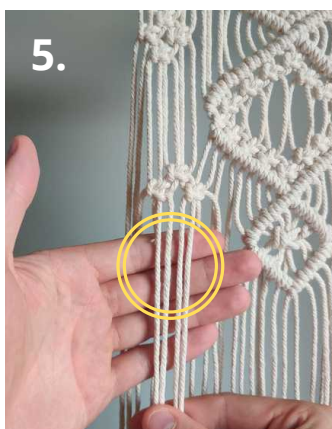

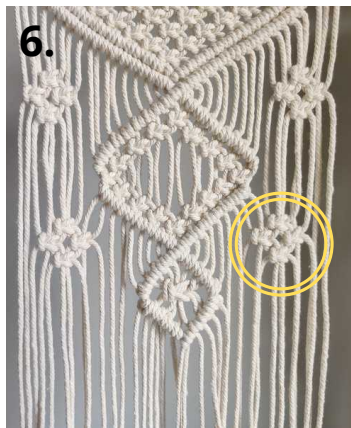
Take **first four** strings from the right side and make another **Square Knot** (1-2). Then grab two strings from the right side + two strings from **Square Knot** above and make another **Square Knot** (3).



Leave on the side two strings and using another two strings next to each other make **Square Knot**. Make the same at the bottom (4-5).

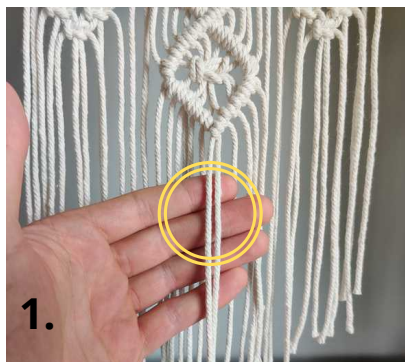

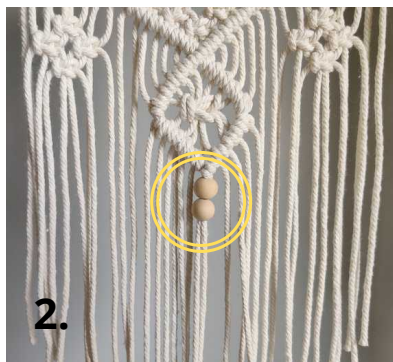

Take two middle strings from the **Double Half Hitch Knot** section and thread them through the wooden bead (1). Wooden beads in place (2).

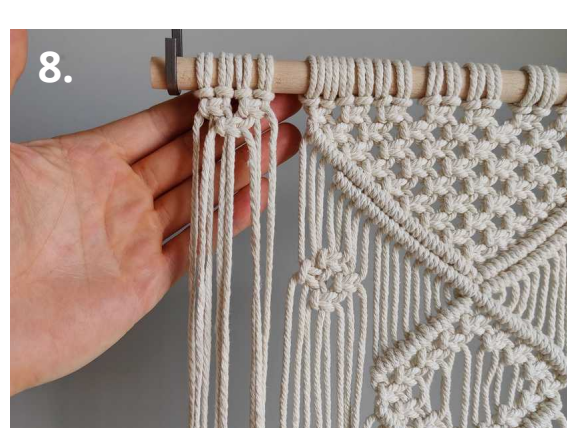
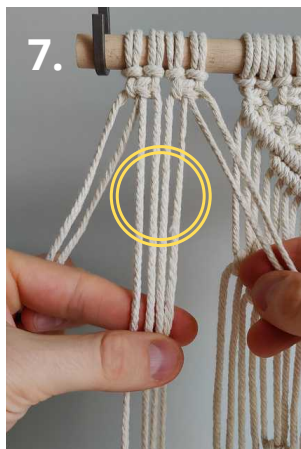
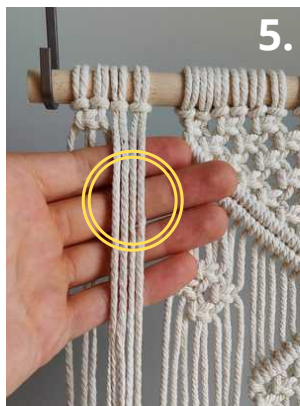
STEP 13

In the end you can trim the ends from the shortest to the longest. Wall Hanging is ready :)



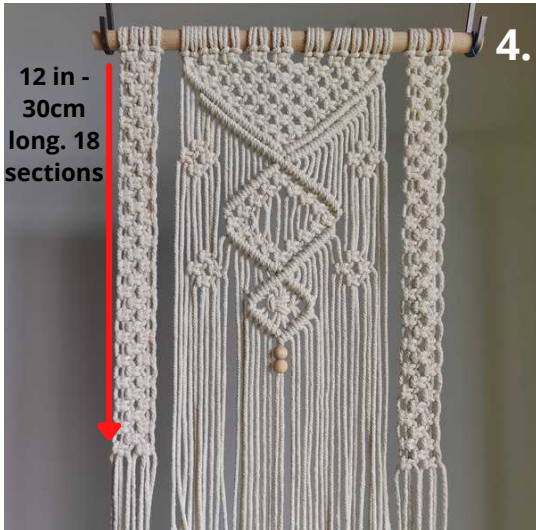
STEP 13 - BONUS PROJECT (PART)

Using 4x 157 inches (4m) strings make four **Lark's Heads Knots** (1). Make sure the ends are even (2). Grab four strings on the left side and make a **Square Knot** (3-4). Repeat the same on the right side and in the middle (5-8). **THIS IS FIRST SECTION. MAKE IN TOTAL 18 SECTIONS LIKE THAT**



STEP 14

Repeat previous steps. Left-Right-Middle with the **Square Knots** (1-3). Make in total 18 sections like that - **12 inches (30cm) long on the both sides** (4)



STEP 15

Grab two strings from each side (1) and connect them with one **Square Knot** - **yellow circle**(2)

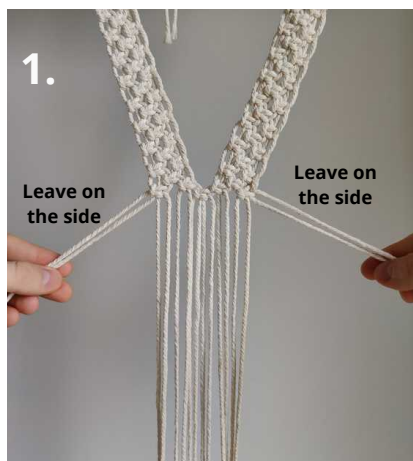


This is how it should look. Only make one **Square Knot** in the middle at this point

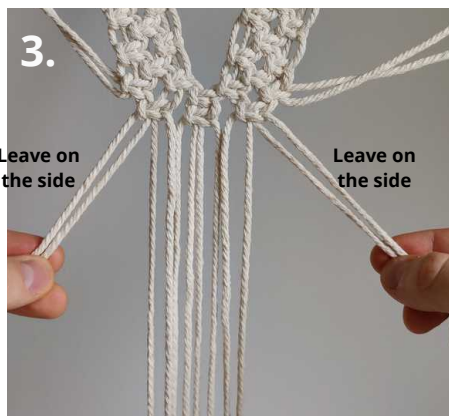

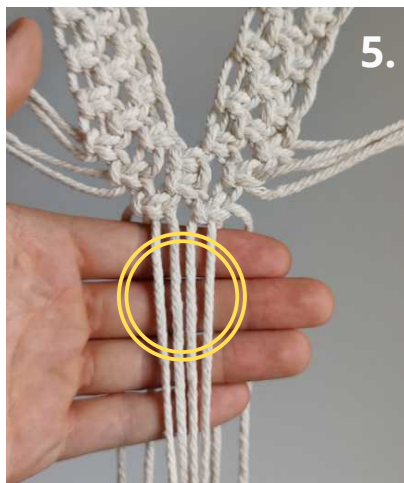
Leave two strings from the left and the right (1) on the side and make **3 Square Knots** next to each other (2).



Leave another two strings from the left and the right (3) on the side and make **2 Square Knots** next to each other (4).



In the end grab four middle strings and make **one Square Knot** (5-6)



STEP 17

Using two outer strings make **Double Half hitch Knot** section going to the center (1-2). In the end trim and brush out each string (3).

Materials:

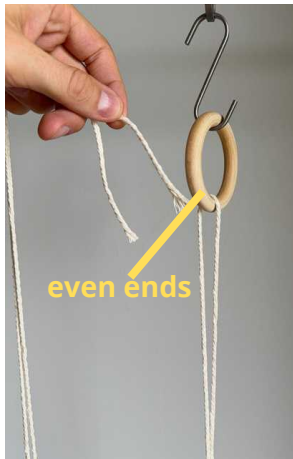
- 4 cords 165 inches (4.2m) each
- wooden ring 2.75 inch (7cm)
- 6x wooden beads
- measuring tape
- scissors



STEP 1

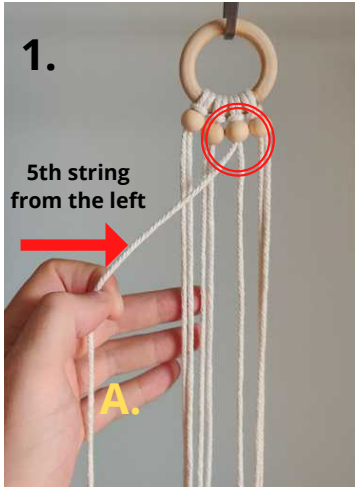
Using 165 inches (4.2m) string make **4 Lark's Heads Knots**(1). **MAKE SURE THE ENDS OF THE CORD ARE EVEN** - if not, you will ran out of string in some point.

Then take 12mm wooden beads and using needle threader, thread them through each string (2).

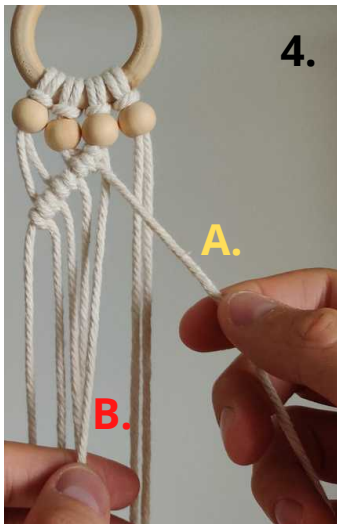


STEP 2

Starting with third **Lark's Head Knot** (left string of this knot), make a **Diagonal Double Half Hitch Knot** section (1-2). **Double Half Hitch Knot** section the left side is ready (3). Repeat the same on the right side. **A. is your holding string** and **B. working string** (4)



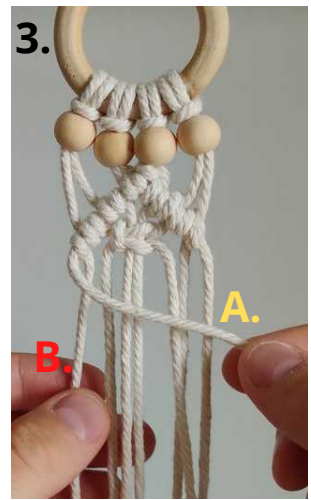
Right side of **Double Half Hitch Knot** section is ready (5).



STEP 3

Grab four strings and make **Square Knot** - yellow circle (1-2). Make another **Double Half Hitch Knot** section on the left side going to the center.

A cord is holding cord and the rest **working cords** (3-4)

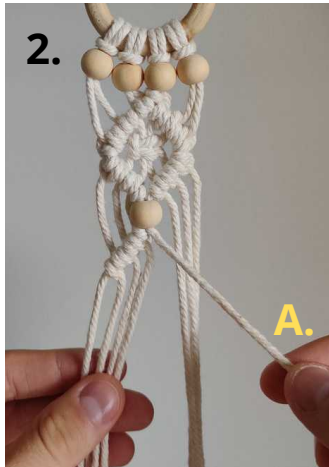
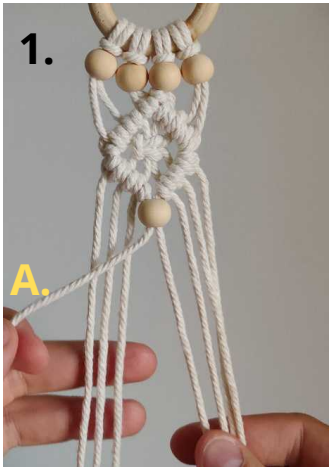


Repeat the same on the right side (5). Then grab two strings from the middle and thread the bead through them (6-7).

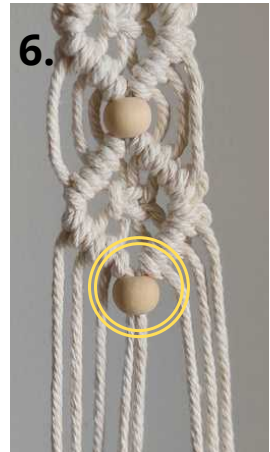
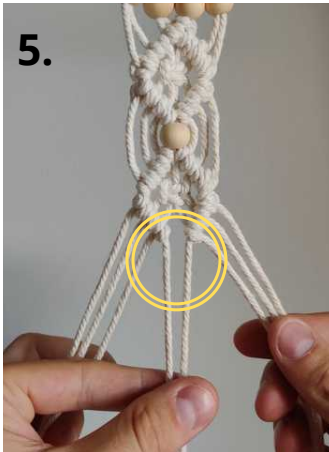


STEP 4

Grab left string and make another section of **Double Half Hitch Knot** (1) and repeat the same on the right side (2). Then, make a **Square Knot** in the middle (3). Repeat **Diagonal Double Half Hitch Knot** on both sides (4).



Grab two strings from the middle and thread the bead through them - yellow circle (5-6).

Once more repeat below steps and make another

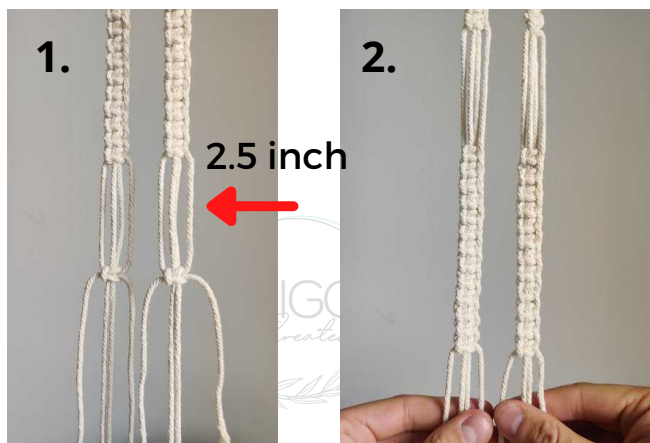
STEP 6

Starting with the four strings on the left side (1) - make a section of **19 Square Knots** (2). Repeat the same on the right side (3-4).



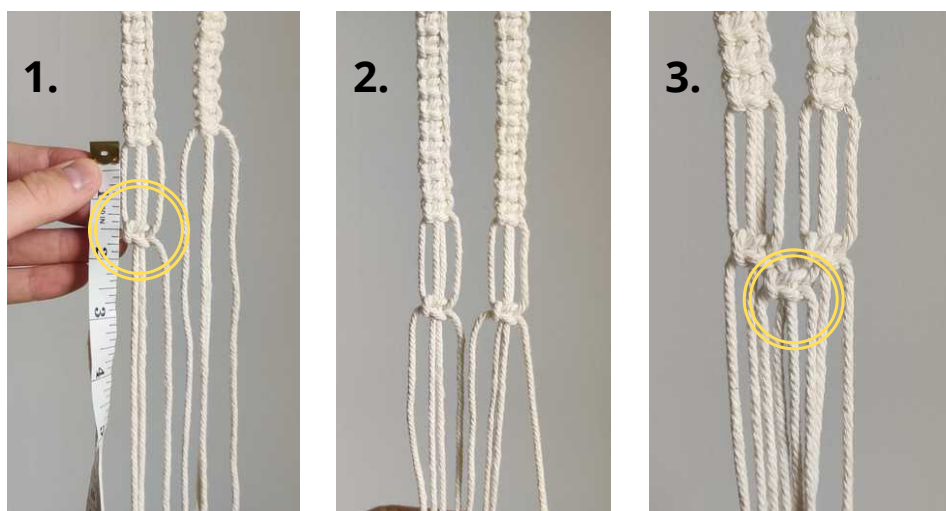
STEP 7

2.5 inches - 6cm below make another section of **Square Knots** (1) - **13 Square Knots** on the left and the right side (2).



STEP 8

1.5 inches - 4cm below make another section of **Square Knots** on both sides (1-2). Now connect both sides with another **Square Knot** (3).



Then repeat previous steps. Make a **Square Knots** on the left and the right side and connect in the middle (4-6).

In the end trim the ends from the shortest to the longest.

Macrame Plant Hanger

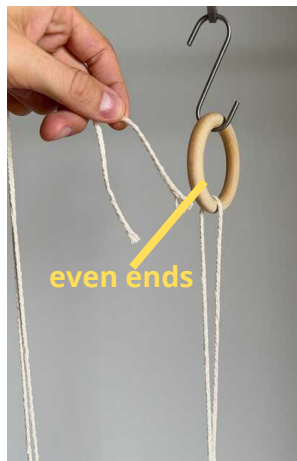
Materials:

- 8 cords 178 inches (4.5m) each
- 1 cord 20 inches (50cm)
- 3 wooden beads
- wooden ring
- measuring tape
- scissors



STEP 1

Using 178 inches (4.5m) cord make **8 Lark's Heads Knots**. **MAKE SURE THE ENDS OF THE CORD ARE EVEN** - if not, you will ran out of string in some point. Then separate them into 4 arms (**1arm=4strings**(2). Take first arm on the left side and make **6 Square Knots** (3-4)

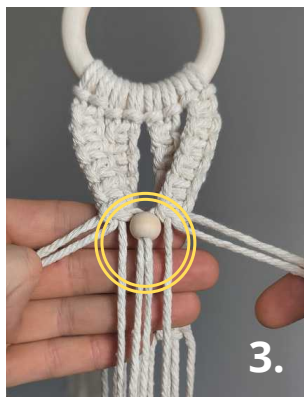


Ready **6 Square Knots** on the left side(4). Repeat the same on the right side(5).
For the middle arms make **10 Square Knots** (6).



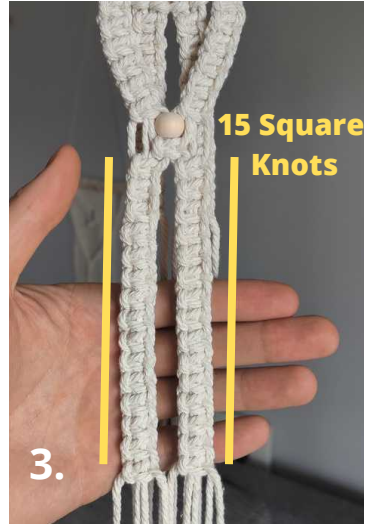
STEP 2

Take two inner strings from the shortest arms and thread them through the wooden bead(1-2). Then grab four middle strings (**yellow circle**) and make one **Square Knot** (3-4).



STEP 3

On the left side grab four strings and make **15 Square Knots**. Repeat the same on the right side (1-3)

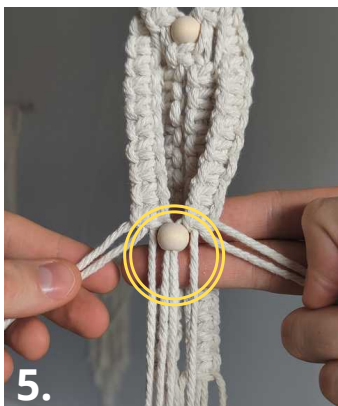


STEP 4

Grab two **middle** arms from the **Step 1** and make another **4 Square Knots**.
*These two middle arms should have **14 Square Knots** in total.*

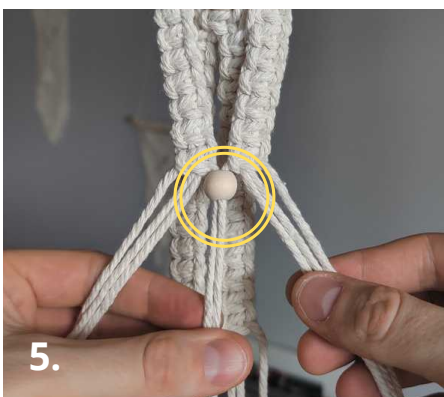
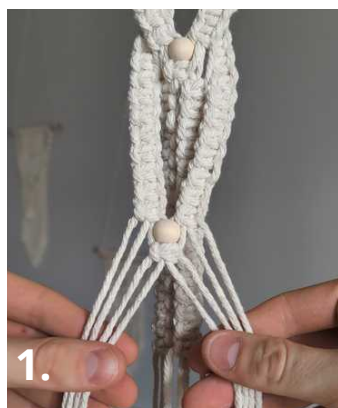


Once again grab two **middle** strings and thread the wooden bead through them (4). Using four middle strings (**yellow circle** -5) secure the bead with **one Square Knot** (6).



STEP 5

Take four strings from the left and the right side and make **13 Square Knots** (1-2). Then using the outer arms take two strings and thread them through the **last third wooden bead** (3-5)

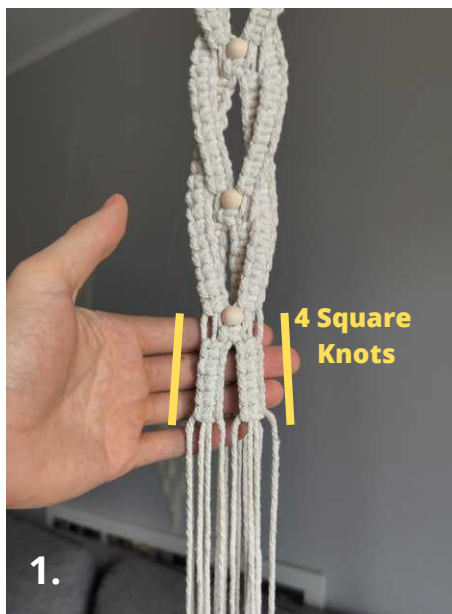


Grab four middle strings (**yellow circle** -6) and secure the bead with **one Square Knot** (7).



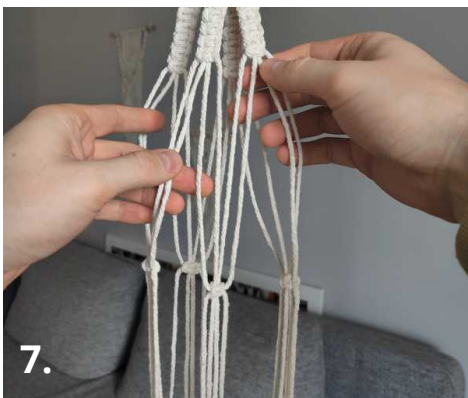
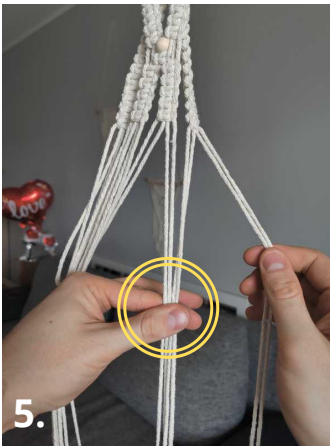
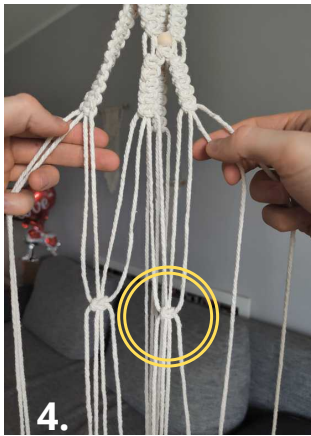
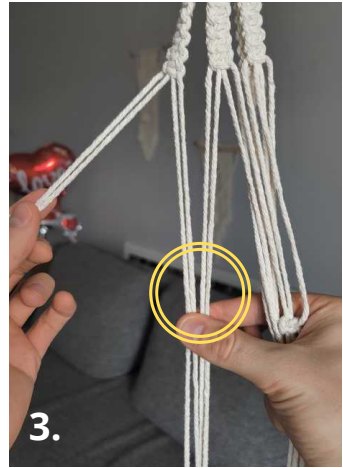
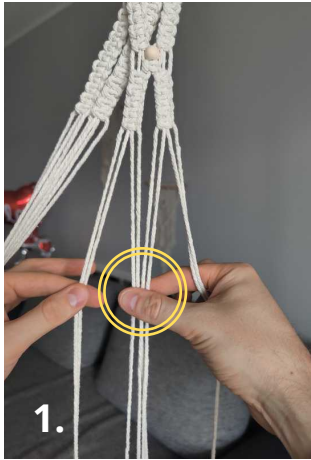
STEP 6

Make on the left and the right side **four Square Knots(1)**. This is how this part of plant hanger should look like. 4 arms should be equal (2)

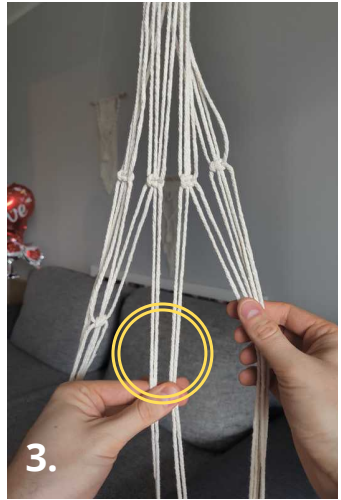
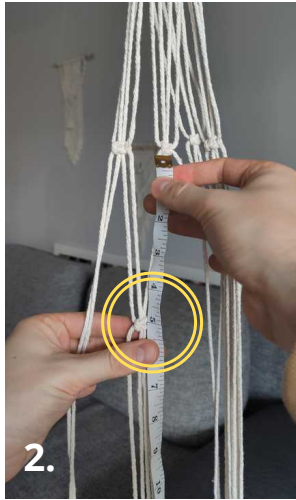
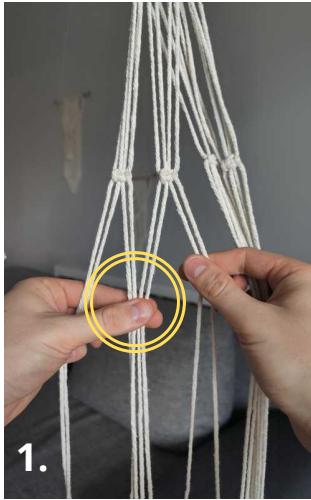
6 inches -15cm below the **Square Knots** section, grab two arms next to each other and take two strings from each side, which are adjacent (1) and make a **Square Knot** (2). Repeat the same for each arm (3-6).



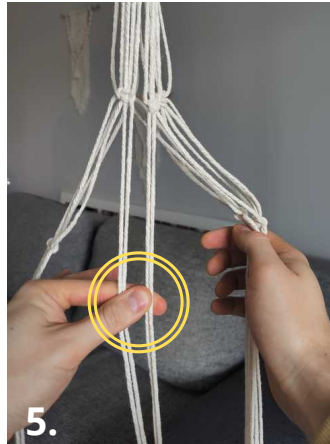
As you can see something like a basket was created with four **Square Knots** around (7).

STEP 8

Once more, having two arms next to each other, take two strings from each side, which are adjacent (1) and make a **Square Knot** (2), 5 inches -13cm below the previous **Square Knot** section. Repeat the same around (3-6).



Ready four **Square Knots** next to each other- around (6)



As you can see something like a second basket was created with four **Square Knots** around (7).



STEP 9

4 inches -11cm below the **Square Knot** section grab all the cords and using one 20inches -50cm cord make a **Wrapping Knot (page 8-9)**.

In the end you can trim the ends (6). Plant hanger is finished.

Materials:

- wooden dowel 5.9in (15cm)
- 12x cords 67 inches (1.7m)
- scissors

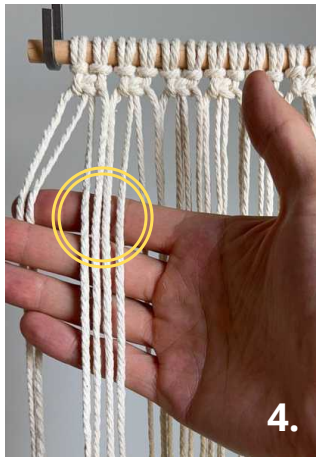
STEP 1

Using 67 inches (1.7m) cord make **12 Lark's Heads Knots**(1). **MAKE SURE THE ENDS OF THE CORD ARE EVEN** - if not, you will ran out of string in some point. Then grab four strings and make one **Square Knot** (2). Repeat the same all the way to have in total **6 Square Knots** (3).



STEP 2

Leave on the side two strings on the left and the right side (4). Then take four strings and make **Square Knot**. Next grab another four strings and make another Square Knot (5). Total **5 Square Knots** should be created in this row (6).

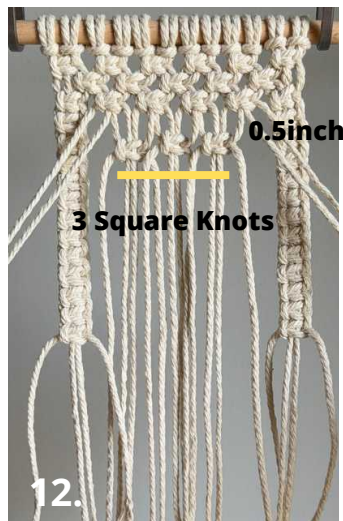


STEP 3

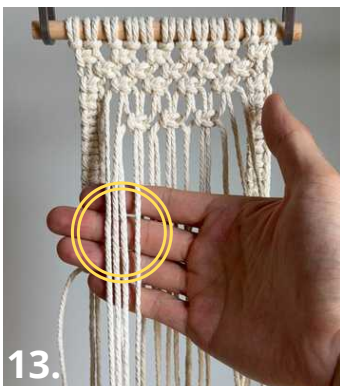
Now starting with the first four cords make in this row **6 Square Knots** (7-8). Take once more first four cords and make another **12 Square Knots** (9). Repeat the same on the right side (10).



Leave on the side two strings and starting with four strings (11) make **3 Square Knots** about 0.5 inches (1.3cm) below the Square Knots created above.



Grab four strings and make in this row four **Square Knots** (13-14). These 4 **Square Knots** should be positioned roughly in the center of the **12 Square Knots** (Arm) you previously made. Then grab once more four cords and make two **Square Knots** on the left and the right side (15).



Position the square knots so they're level with the ends of the strap (16).

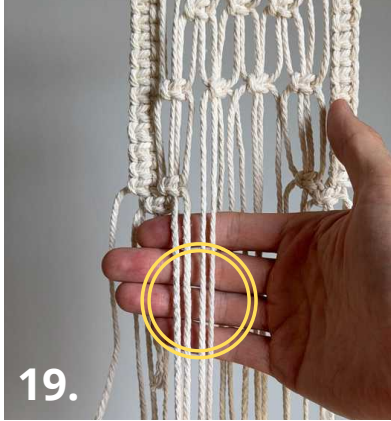
STEP 4

Starting from the left side - grab four strings and make one **Square Knot** (17).

Repeat the same on the right side. Both sides are ready (18).



Take another four strings and make additional **3 Square Knots** (19). In total this row should have **5 Square Knots** (20). First row is completed.



STEP 5

This step might seem a bit more difficult, so feel free to use the video attached at the beginning of this project for guidance.

*For the second row, set aside 4 cords on each side (left and right) and make **4 square knots** (21-22)

*For the third row, set aside 6 cords on each side and make **3 square knots** (23-24)

*For the fourth row, set aside 8 cords on each side and make **2 square knots**. (25-26)

*For the final row, make **1 square knot** (27-28).

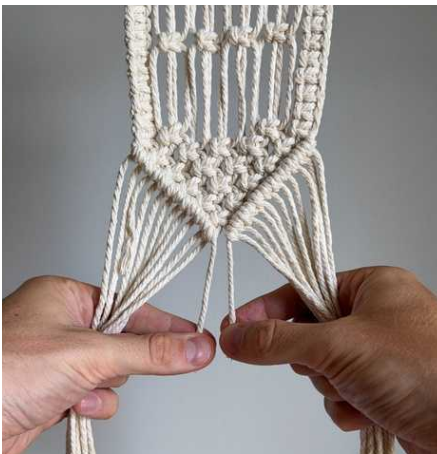


All the rows are complete

If you find this step to be too difficult, you may skip to step 6.

Starting from the left side make section of **Double Half Hitch Knot (page 9-12)**.

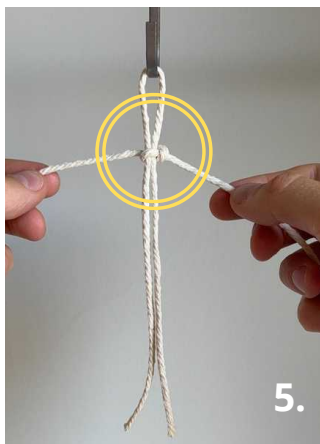
- 1x cord 14 inches (36cm)
- 1x cord 51 inches (130cm)
- 1x cord 15 inches (38cm)
- 1 wooden bead
- scissors

STEP 1

Use one 14 inches (36cm) cord and hang it on the hook (1). Then using one 51 inches (130cm) cord make a **Square Knot** (2-5)



First Square Knot is ready

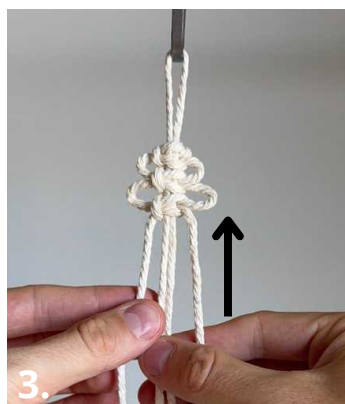
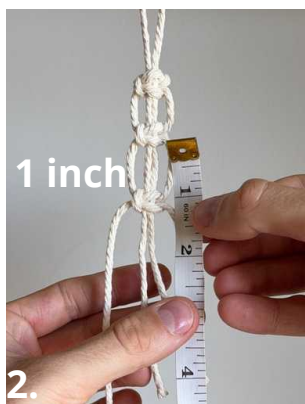
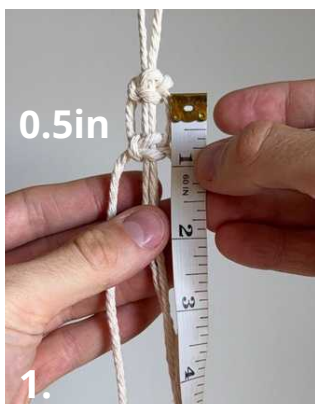


STEP 2

Create another **Square Knot** 0.5 inches (1.2cm) below the first **Square Knot** (1).

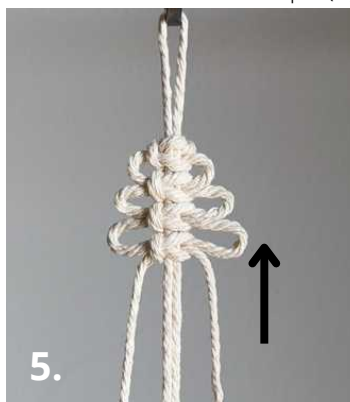
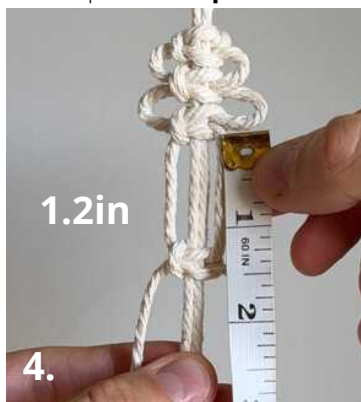
Then make another **Square Knot** 1inch (2.5cm) below the second one (2).

Now pull these two square knots upwards to form a tree shape (3).

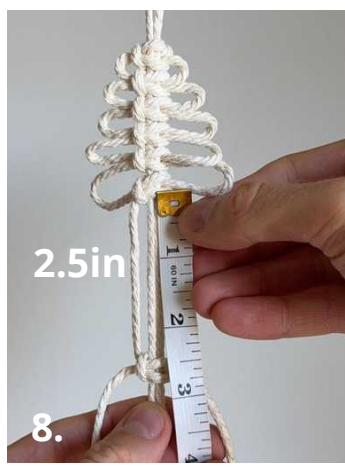
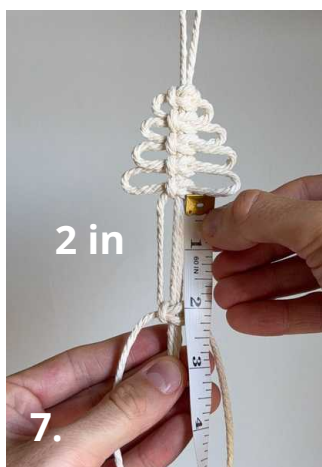


Then make another **Square Knot** 1.2 inch (3 cm) below the third one (4).

Now pull this **Square Knot** upwards to form a tree shape (5).



Next make another **Square Knot** 1.5 inches (3.8cm) below the fourth one and pull it upwards (6). Then make another one 2 inches (5cm) below and pull upwards and then the last one 2.5 inches (6.3 inches) below (7-9).



In the end thread the wooden bead through the cord (10) and then take one 15 inches cord and make two **Square Knots** (11-16).





In the ends brush out the ends and trim them a little bit (16).



Project is ready.



Macrame Ornament

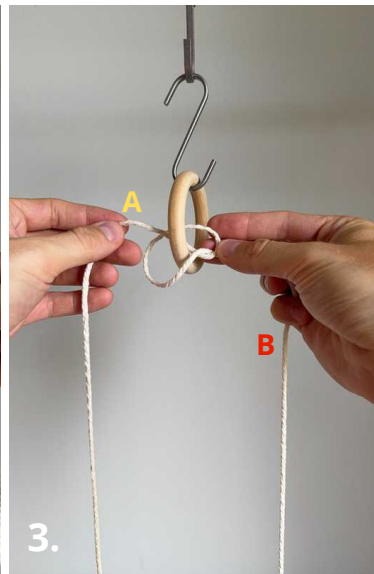
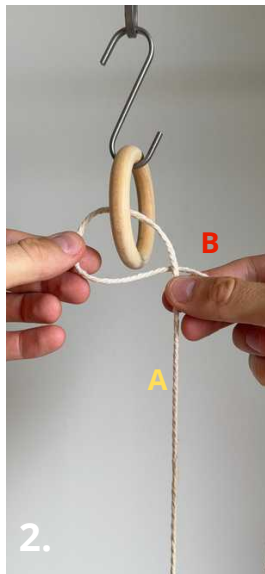
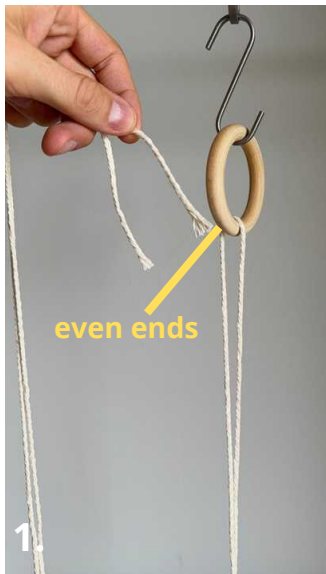

Materials:

- 1x cord 177 inches (4.5m)
- 1x wooden ring 70mm
- 2x wooden beads

STEP 1

Using a 177-inch (4.5m) cord, make a section of **Spiral Knots** (page 7-8) around the wooden ring. *BUT make sure the ends are even (1).* Cross the "B" cord under the "A" cord (2). Next, take the "A" cord under the "B" cord, and up through wooden ring hole (3). Pull both outer strings out (4).



Repeat the same around the wooden ring doing **Spiral Knots** section



Take ends of the cord and tape them (7-8). Using a bead, thread the cord through it. (9-10).



Macrame Christmas Ornament is ready (10). *You can use different projects to make from this video*

Macrame Feathers

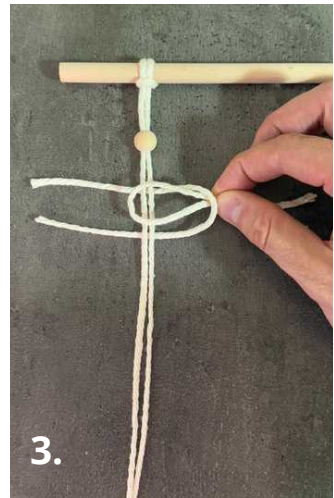
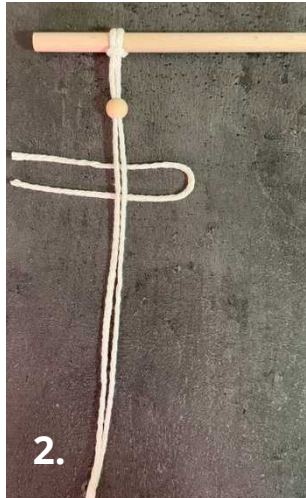

Materials:

- 1x 24.5 inches (62m) cord - spine
- 26x 8inches (20cm) cord
- 2x wooden beads
- 1x wooden dowel 5.9in (15cm)
- fabric scissiors

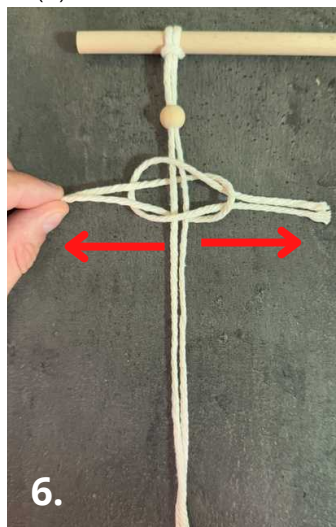
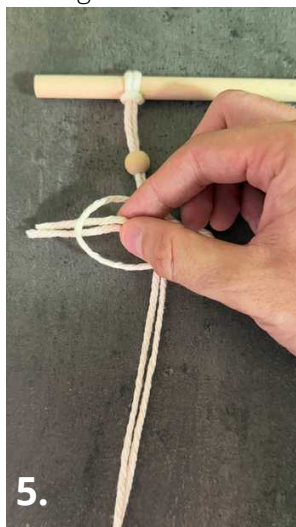
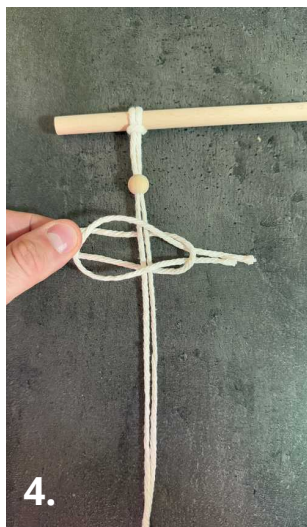
STEP 1

Fold the 24.5inches (62cm) string in half and make a **Lark's Head Knot**. Tape the ends and thread them through wooden bead (1). Take one of the 8 inches -20cm string, fold it in half and tuck it under the spine (main string)(2). Take another 8in string (20cm), put it in half and insert it into the loop of the top horizontal string (3).

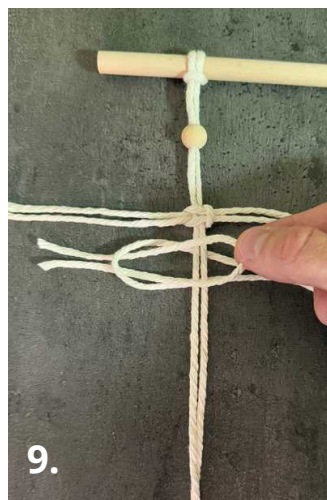
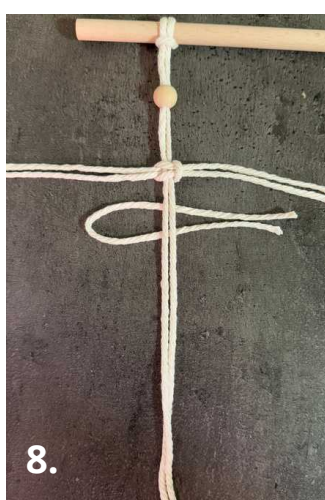
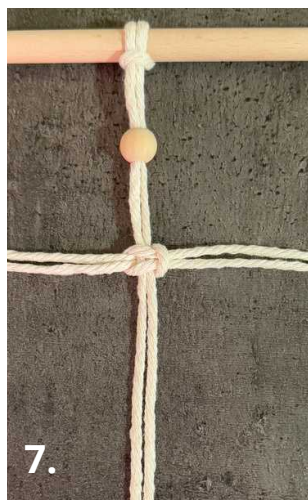


Pull it through and lay it horizontally, on top of the opposing string (4-5). After that, pull the bottom string all the way through the top string(5).

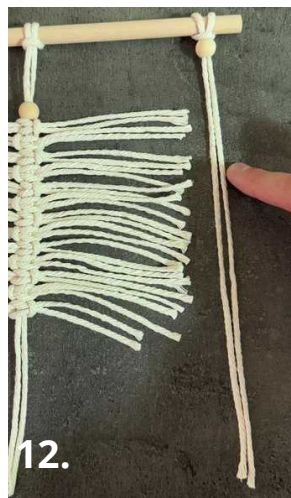
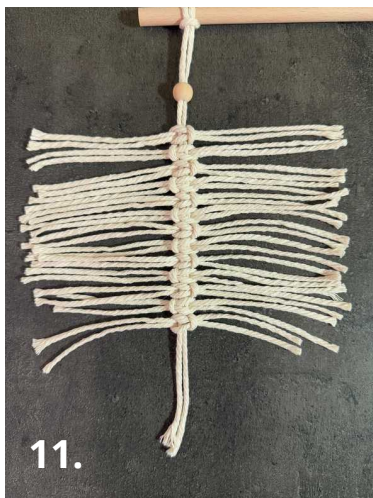
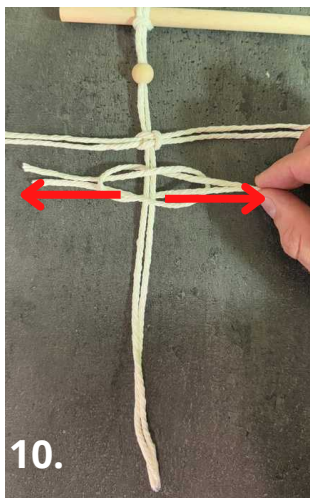
Pull the strings from the both sides (6).



Your final knot should look as on the below photo (7) - **Square Knot**. For the next row, you have to change the starting side (8). Lay the string reverse. Lay the first folded string under the main string and thread folded string into its loop(9).



Pull the lower string through the top loop (10). Pull the cords from both sides (10). Continue the same steps for the rest of the strings to the bottom. There should be 13 Square knots (11). Repeat the same on the right side (12), but you can start doing **Square Knots** little bit lower.



Once both sides are ready use a comb to brush out the cord. Just make sure to use a comb with closely spaced teeth (13). This will help you comb out the cord more thoroughly (14). **IMPORTANT: Use hairspray and spray it onto the brushed-out cords. This will help you with cutting them later, as the cords will become stiffer**



STEP 2

Once the cords are brushed out and sprayed with hairspray, use the template, which you can download via the QR code next to this step. If you're unable to download it, simply trim the cords to create a leaf shape.
